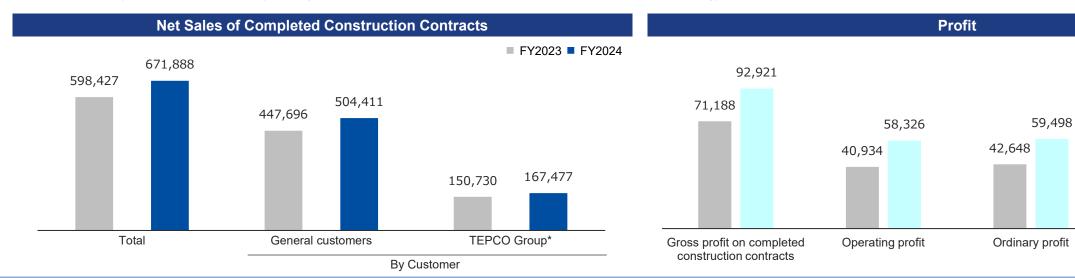

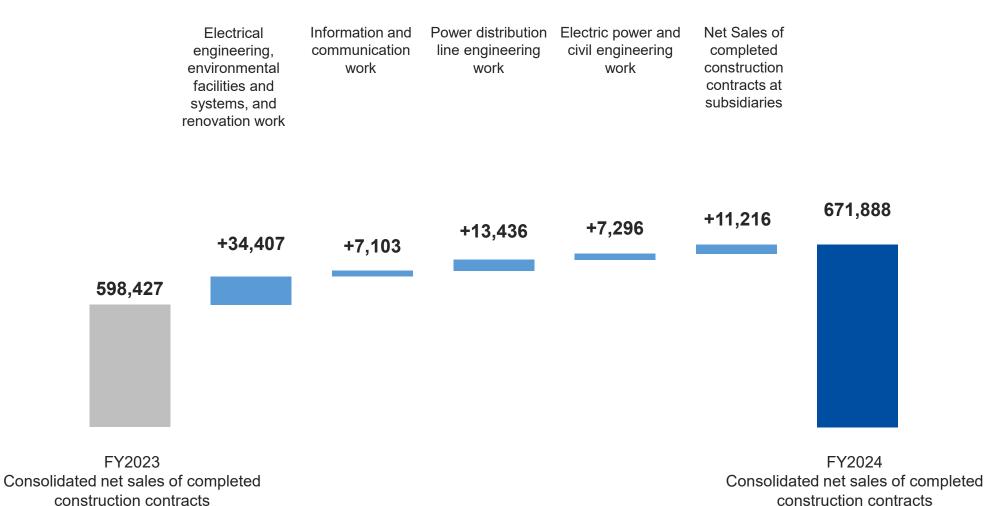

### (1) Factors for year-on-year changes in net sales of completed construction contracts (consolidated)





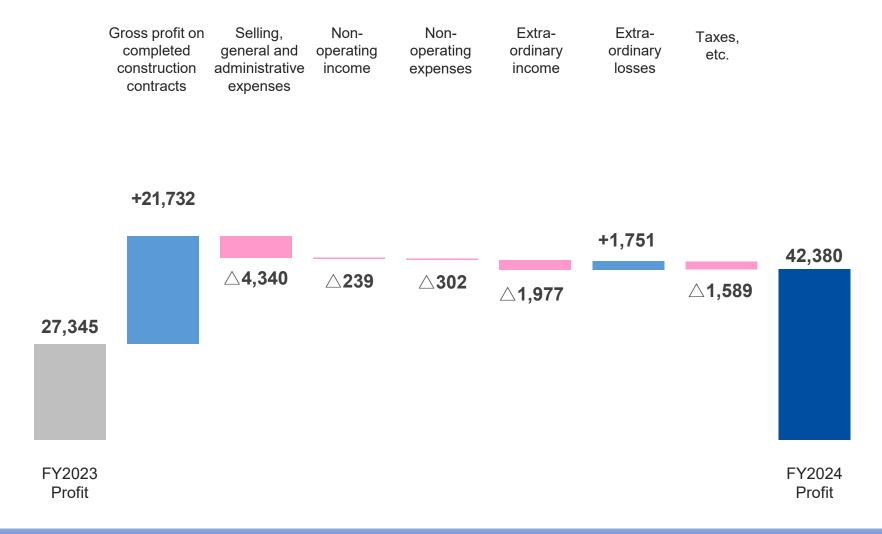

#### (1) Factors for year-on-year changes in profit (consolidated)





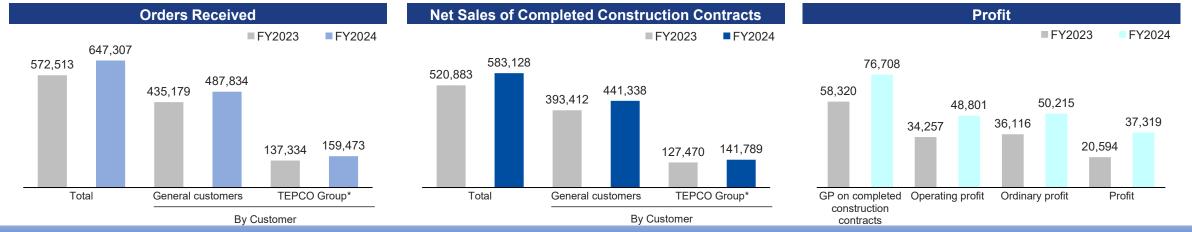

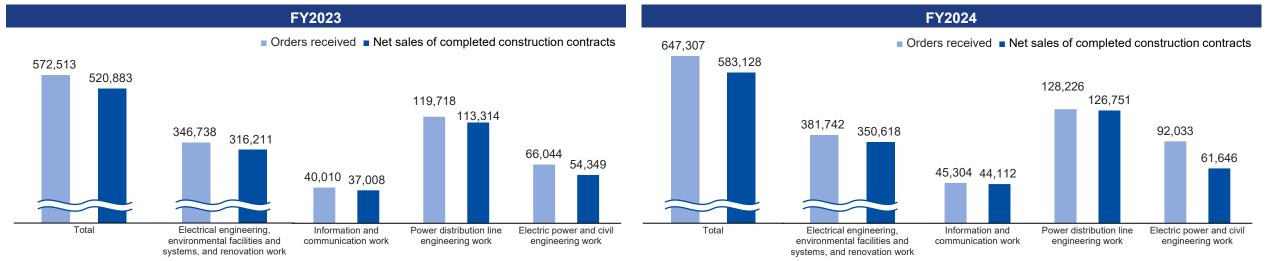

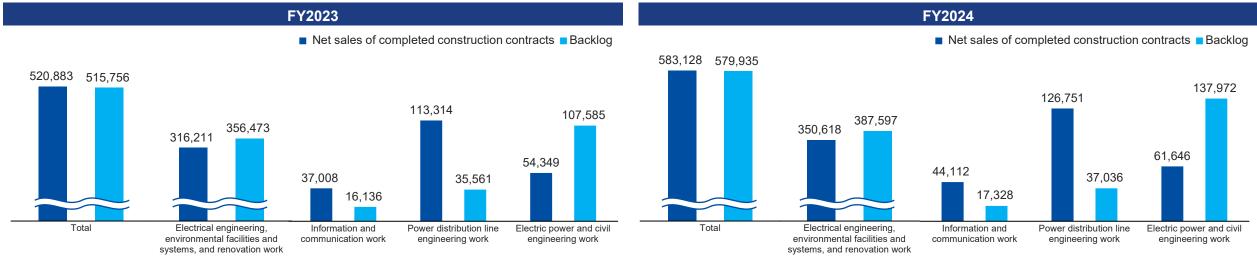

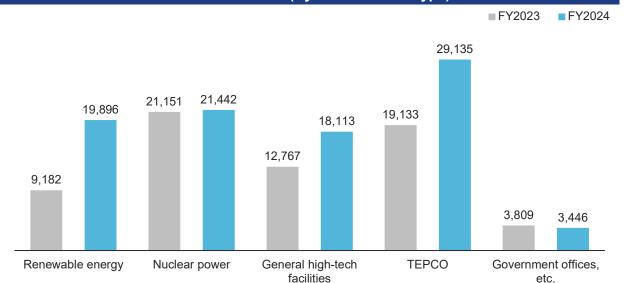

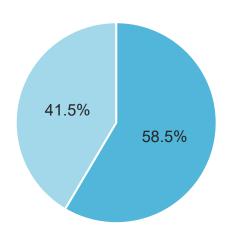
